**TRAINEE TRAVEL BURSARY PROGRAM  
BOURSE DE VOYAGES POUR LES ETUDIANTS**

The Canadian Association of Neuropathologists Endowment Trust has established a grant program to assist residents in Neuropathology or other accredited Laboratory Medicine Residency training programs, as well as undergraduate and postgraduate students in Neuroscience, to attend the Annual Meeting of the Association for the purpose of presenting a diagnostic case or delivering an abstract. The total amount in this award program will be a maximum of \$3,000 per annum, and the value of each award will be the division of this sum by the number of eligible applicants, up to a maximum of \$750 per applicant. Because this Program is intended to supplement existing funding, original receipts for expenses not otherwise or only partially reimbursed must be provided; granted funds will reflect the subtraction of existing funding from the total expenses.

Each applicant to the Bursary Program will be required to submit a letter from a co-author who is a Member in good standing of the Association describing the nature of the applicant's participation in the presentation. Payment of the award will normally be contingent upon submission of receipts. Applications for the award program should be submitted to the Secretary-Treasurer of the CANP.

Changes in the amount in the Bursary Program, upon the recommendation of the Endowment Trust Committee, will require approval by the membership of the Association at an Annual Business Meeting.
